 - · Ngā Waihua o Paerangi will require the applicant to provide the
 - 1. Bank account verification for the account the funding is to be deposited into;
 - 2. Financial control policy, i.e. which named personnel within the organisation have access to and authority to spend money from that account; and
 - Child protection policy (in respect of the provision of children's services) if children's services (as that term is defined in the Vulnerable Children Act 2014) are being provided as part of this initiative.
 - 4. Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 policy.
 - Ngā Waihua o Paerangi may undertake a credit check on applicants and / or any key person or organisation associated with a short-listed application having access to the bank account identified in accordance with 2(2) above.
 - Ngā Waihua o Paerangi may undertake a criminal history check on individuals, or any key person associated with the application or delivery of the proposed initiative. A key person is any person that Ngā Waihua o Paerangi considers as exercising significant influence over management and / or decision making in relation to the application.
